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Federal Program

Congressional appropriation to EPA EPA capitalization grant to states States provide low-interest loans and subsidy to drinking water systems

State Program

Annual sales tax appropriation Provide low-interest loans and subsidy to "political subdivisions"

Congressional appropriation to EPA EPA capitalization grant to states States provide low-interest loans and subsidy for point source and non-point source projects

Emergency Funding

- Board action required
- What is an emergency?

"An unexpected, serious occurrence or situation requiring urgent or immediate action. With regard to a water system this would be a situation resulting from the failure of equipment or other infrastructure, or contamination of the water supply, which threatens the health and/or safety of the public/water users. "

Division of Water Quality Water Quality Related

Emergency Funding

- Provided out of state fund
- Board action is required



The Process

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Application

- One application
 - Federal and State Programs
 - Planning and Construction
 - System Capacity Evaluation
 - Technical
 - Managerial
 - Financial

Authorization

- The Drinking Water Board authorizes all assistance from the DWSRF programs
- Meets 6 times per year
- Applications due 60 days prior to the meeting

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Applications

- Planning, Design, and Construction Assistance
- Cost & Effectiveness Analysis
- Fiscal Sustainability Plan
- State and Federal Non-Point Source

Authorization

- Water Quality Board authorizes CWSRF assistance
- Meets 8 to 10 times per year
- Applications due 45 days prior to the meeting
